Proposals must focus on projects that result in scholarly and/or creative activity products that help move the university toward national prominence at an R2 standard that warrant 100% Research workload and are beyond the expectations of a typical 30% research workload.

Spotlight on Expanding the NEST

Every month, we will be spotlighting one of the practices for cultivating student success. This is meant to provide tips for implementing the practice.

This month we are spotlighting:

#21: Create intentional and <u>frequent</u> opportunities for students to offer <u>feedback</u> on their learning experience and to suggest ideas for improvement.

This month, you have the opportunity to assess if you have built in enough <u>formative</u> <u>assessment</u> opportunities for ascertain students' understanding, attitudes, or skills related to the course material.

September is an opportunity for faculty to work on both increasing feedback for their Fall 2024 courses in preparation for mid-semester feedback and planning how to increase <u>formative</u> <u>assessment</u> opportunities. Formative assessments are usually low-stakes activities that may or may not contribute to the final grade, but they are useful in helping educators monitor learning and adjust their teaching accordingly.

In addition to creating frequent and intentional opportunities to measure student learning, you should consider soliciting mid-semester <u>feedback</u>. This is an excellent "just-in-time" method to improve your teaching and shows students you are responsive to their needs. As October approaches, you should consider how you will gather midsemester feedback.
