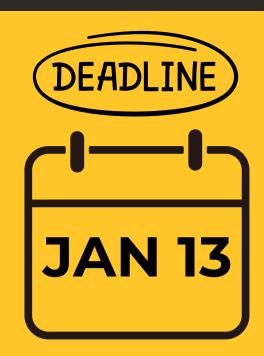

#1: Build rapport through icebreakers, small group activities, collaborative thinking, tone, etc.

As you launch your spring courses, it is important to plan how you will build rapport with students. CETL faculty Laura Howard, CETL Faculty Fellow for Learning-Centered Teaching, and Linda Stewart published this <u>article</u> in *Faculty Focus* with tips on how to write a welcome message to your class and more tips on culturally responsive moves to help build community throughout the semester.
