<b>Criterion: Good Practices of SoTL (<a href="#">Felten, 2013</a>)</b>	<p>The proposal describes a completed SoTL project that adheres to good practices of SoTL (i.e., systematic inquiry into student learning and/or one’s own teaching practices in higher education which is situated in context and involves methodologically sound application of appropriate research methods). The project is under the oversight of the IRB when appropriate.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>20 points</b></p>	<p>The proposal describes a study that adheres to good practices of SoTL (i.e., systematic inquiry into student learning and/or one’s own teaching practices in higher education which is situated in context and involves methodologically sound application of appropriate research methods under the oversight of the IRB where appropriate, but the project is not yet complete (e.g., data has not yet been collected or analyzed) or is missing some other key element.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>15 points</b></p>	<p>The proposal focuses on teaching and/or learning (e.g., a session on teaching tips, a literature review on an aspect of teaching, etc.) but does not meet the criteria for good practices in SoTL: systematic inquiry into student learning and/or one’s own teaching practices in higher education which is situated in context and involves methodologically sound application of appropriate research methods (including IRB oversight where appropriate).</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>5 points</b></p>
<b>Criterion: Authorship</b>	<p>The applicant is the lead author on their session.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>15 points</b></p>		<p>The applicant is a collaborating author on their session.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>5 points</b></p>
<b>Criterion: Scope of Conference</b>	<p>According to the conference website, the conference is international in scope, representing a wide, global audience.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>10 points</b></p>	<p>According to the conference website, the conference is national in scope, representing a wide U.S. audience.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>8 points</b></p>	<p>According to the conference website, the conference is regional in scope, representing a statewide or regional audience.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>5 points</b></p>
