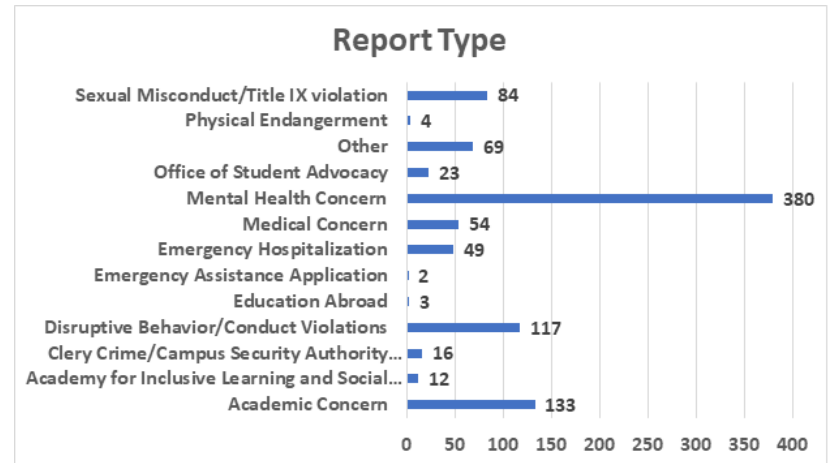
# 22-23 BRT Data by the Numbers

- 659 reports were submitted to BRT

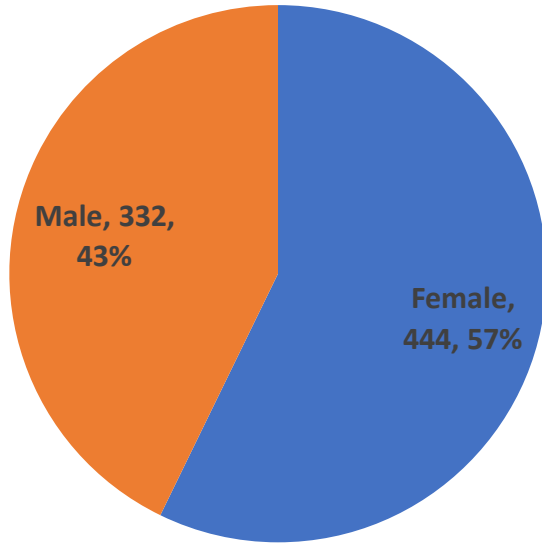

## Report Type

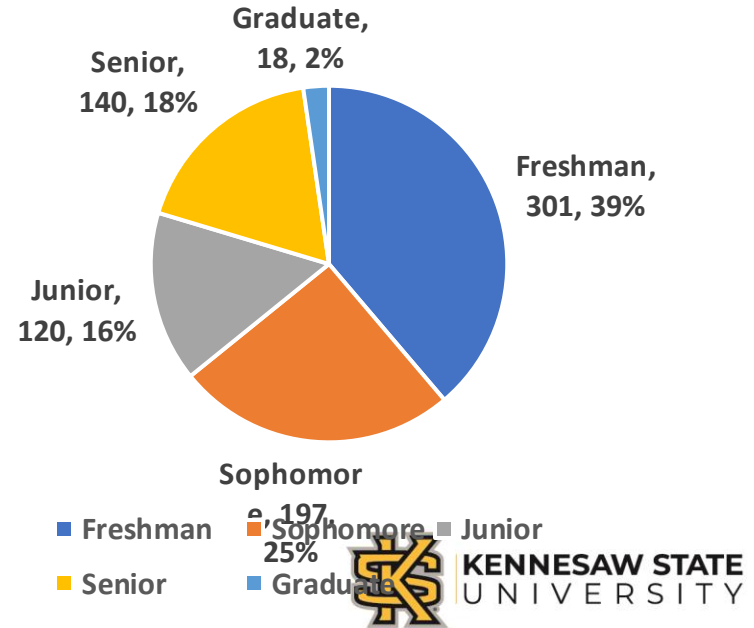

## Binary Gender Designations

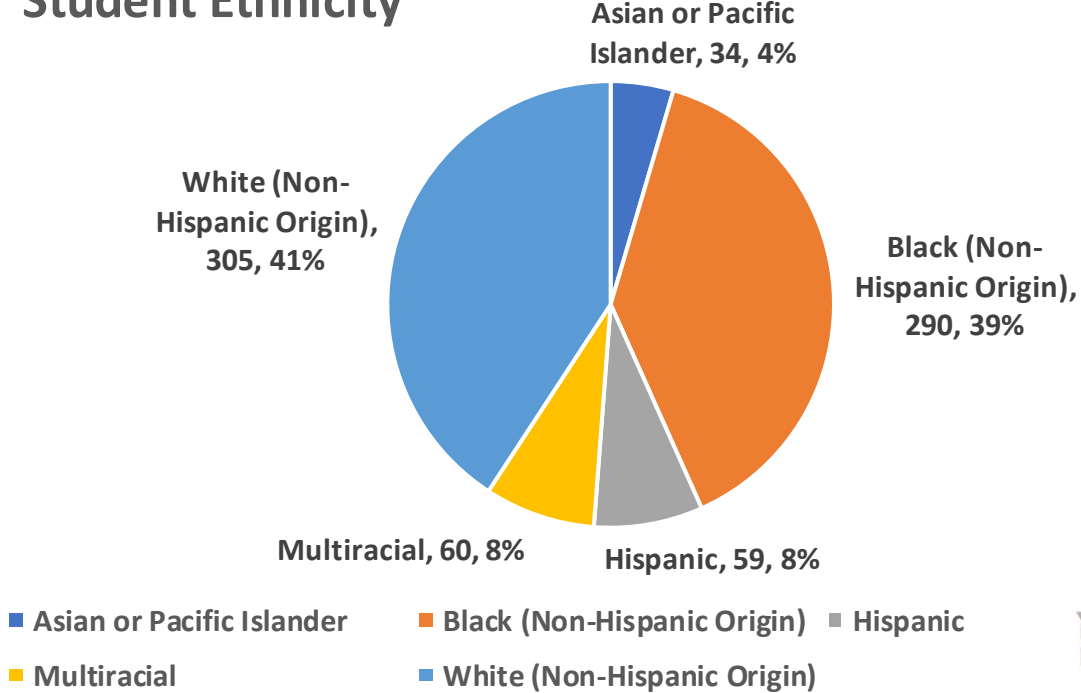


## Class Distinction



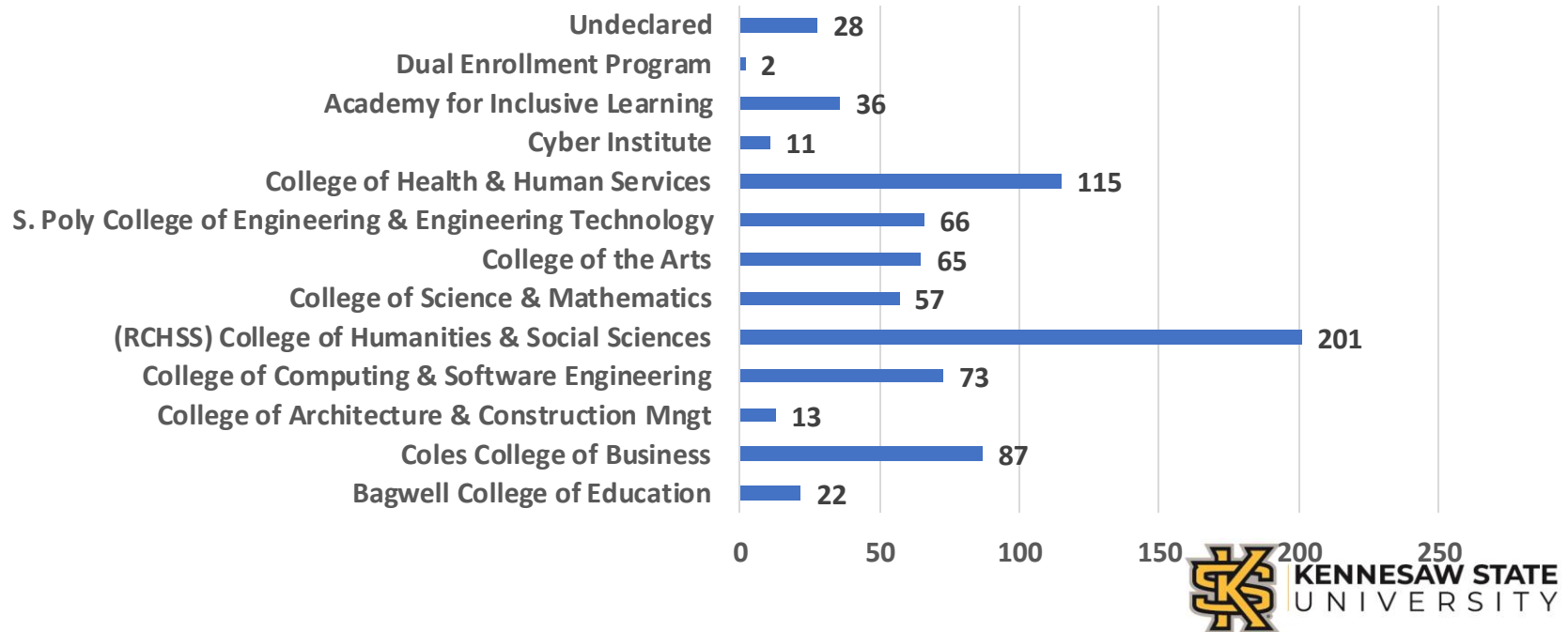
