



Faculty, Get Involved In Research!



FIRST YEAR SCHOLARS PROGRAM

Pairs first-year students with faculty mentors for one year on a research project.

Students: \$2,000.

Faculty: \$1,000 per accepted students for expenses related to the project.

SOPHOMORE SCHOLARS PROGRAM

An extension of the First-Year Scholars Program. Students and faculty receive funding to continue their project into the student's second year.

Students: \$2,000

Faculty: \$1,000 per accepted students for expenses related to the project.

VERTICALLY INTEGRATED PROJECTS

Large-scale, long-term, usually interdisciplinary, projects. Seed funding in first year (\$5,000), expected to be self-sustaining through external funding thereafter.



SUMMER UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH PROGRAM

Students conduct research under the guidance of a full-time tenured or tenure-track faculty. Faculty and students are paid a stipend in order to work collaboratively on a research project in June and July.

UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH AND CREATIVE ACTIVITIES FUNDS

Funds to enhance undergraduate involvement by supporting supplies, personnel, travel for presenting at conferences, data collection, participant incentives, and publication costs.

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis until March 26, 2025, with a funding limit of \$1,000 per student per academic year and \$5,000 per Primary Investigator, with specific guidelines for conference travel.
